Invitation to visit Sarajevo and Mostar

Sarajevo is the capital of Bosnia & Herzegovina. Its name is still associated with the longest siege of a capital city in the history of modern warfare (April 1992 to February 1996). In ancient time, Sarajevo was also called "Jerusalem of Europe" due to its long and peaceful history of religious and cultural diversity.

Mostar is the administrative center of Herzegovina. It is famous for the "Old Bridge", built by the Ottomans in the 16th century.
